Removing Your Ball from The Cup

A practice which has developed since Covid with leaving the flag in place and putting up to 4 balls into the cup before removing them. This practice is causing some issues.

To remove the balls the habit is to grab the flag and give it a good yank. The trouble arises when the flag has some grit in it and the flag does not come out easily. The result is the cup gets pulled up and deforms the green close to the hole.

If a few putts have wavered a bit when approaching the hole recently, this may be the reason.

The advice is to remove the balls from the cup as they are played using carefully either a ball retriever or better still with your fingers.

Give it a try it may improve things for everyone.
